1. Cookie policy

This website does not collect any information automatically, except for the information contained in cookies. By using the pages of this website you consent to the use of cookies in accordance with the policy as set out below. If you do not consent to the use of cookies on our website, you should change your browser settings accordingly or refrain from using the pages of this website.

2. What are cookies?

Cookies are small files saved and stored on your computer, tablet, smartphone or other terminal device when you visit various pages on the internet. A cookie typically contains: the name of the website from which it originated, its 'lifespan' (how long it has existed), and a randomly generated unique number used to identify the browser through which the connection to the website is made.

3. What are cookies used for?

This website uses cookies to:

- maintain the website user's session (after logging in), so that logging in again is not required on every subpage of the website,
- collect anonymous, aggregated statistics that help the creators of this site understand how the pages of the site are used and help improve their functionality and content,
- facilitate use of the website.

4. How long are data stored in cookies?

There are two types of cookies used on the website:

- session cookies – they remain on the user's terminal equipment until the end of the session on the website,
- permanent cookies – they remain on the user's device until they are deleted or their lifetime expires

5. Types of cookies used on the website:

Type	For what they are used
essential cookies	ensure the proper functioning of the pages of the website
performance cookies	collect information about how the pages of the website are viewed
functional cookies	save your settings and personalise your user interface, e.g. the language of the page
